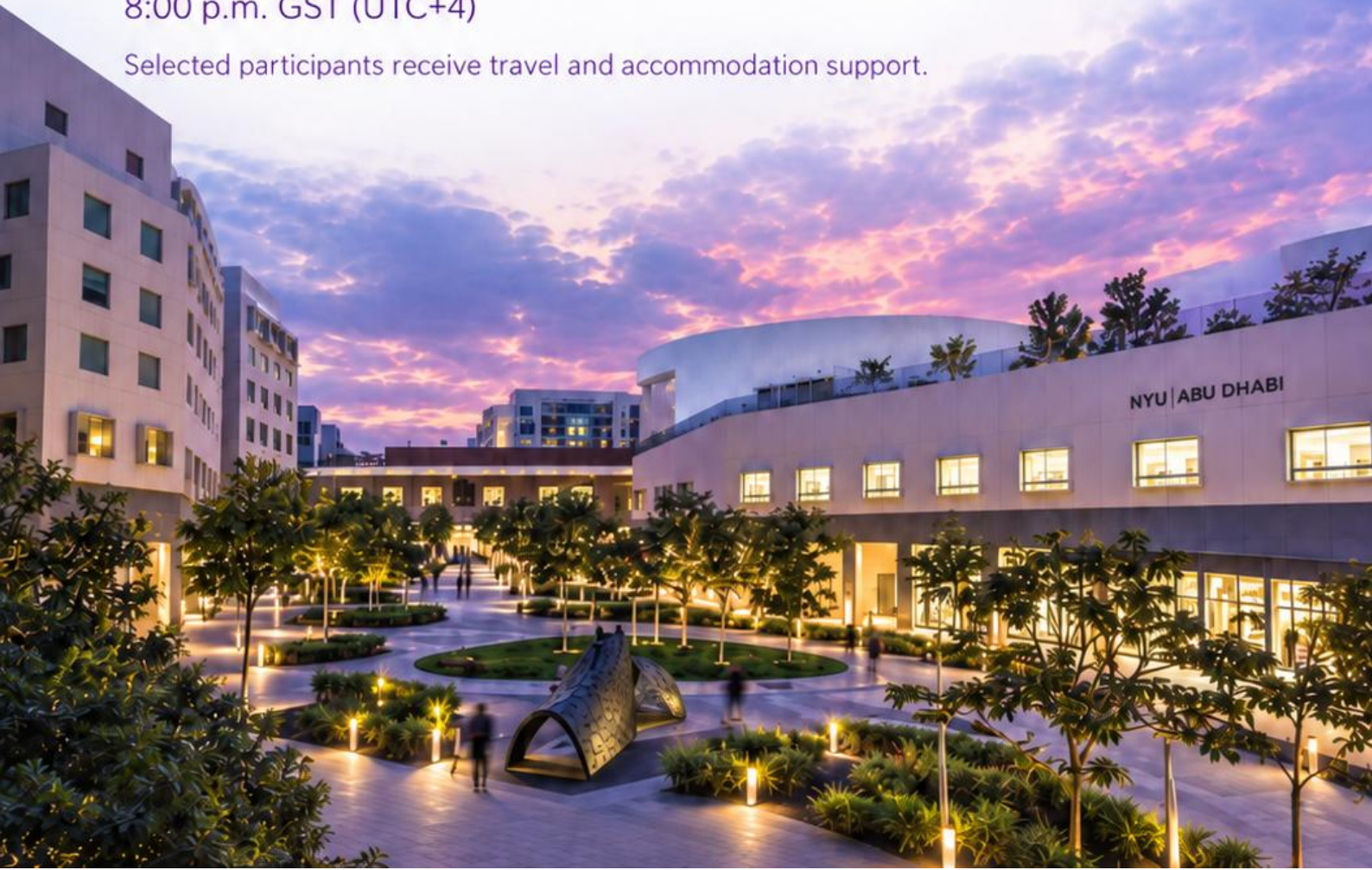
Behavioral and Experimental Economics Job Market Workshop

Behavioral and Experimental Economics Job Market Workshop

NYU Abu Dhabi | November 5-6, 2026.

The [Center for Behavioral Institutional Design](#) (C-BID) at [New York University Abu Dhabi](#) invites applications to a workshop designed for PhD candidates in behavioral and experimental economics who will be on the market this academic year.

The workshop will bring together a select group of advanced PhD students for an intensive one-and-a-half-day program at NYU Abu Dhabi. We particularly welcome applicants whose research also demonstrates strong skills in theoretical or empirical methods, and intellectual ambition. Participants will present their job-market papers and receive detailed feedback from faculty members.

The aim of the workshop is to help participants strengthen both their research and its presentation ahead of the academic job market. In addition to formal paper discussions, the participants will have opportunities to interact with faculty and fellow behavioral and experimental economists on the market this academic year.

ELIGIBILITY

We welcome applications from PhD candidates who:

- Expect to be on the academic job market in 2026-2027;
- Conduct research in behavioral or experimental economics.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Applications are welcome from candidates at institutions around the world.

For each selected participant, the workshop will provide:

- Round-trip economy-class travel to Abu Dhabi; and
- On-campus accommodation for three nights -- arrival November 4th, departure November 7th.

There is no registration fee.

APPLICATION MATERIALS & DEADLINE

All materials should be submitted through the following [application link](#) by **September 30th, 2026, 8 p.m. Gulf Standard Time (UTC+4)**.

Applications will be reviewed competitively on the basis of the quality and promise of the research, fit with the workshop's themes, and the potential value of the workshop for the candidate's job-market preparation. Selected participants will be notified by **October 9th, 2026**.

Applicants should submit:

1. Their job-market paper or an advanced draft;
2. A current curriculum vitae.
